Lord God, heavenly King, O God almighty Father.

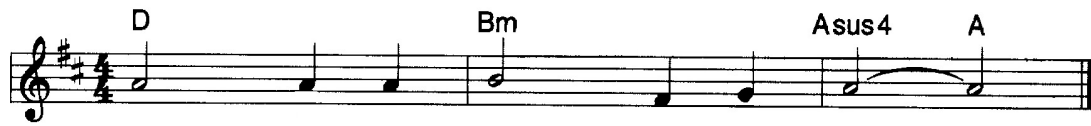
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son,

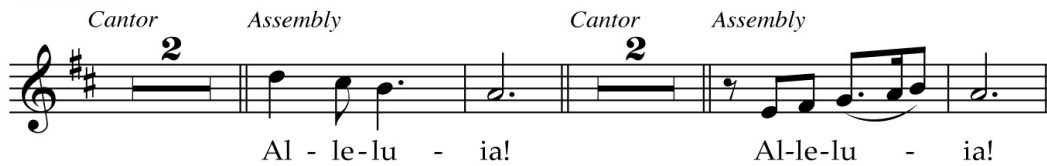
