And I will raise you up on the last day.***

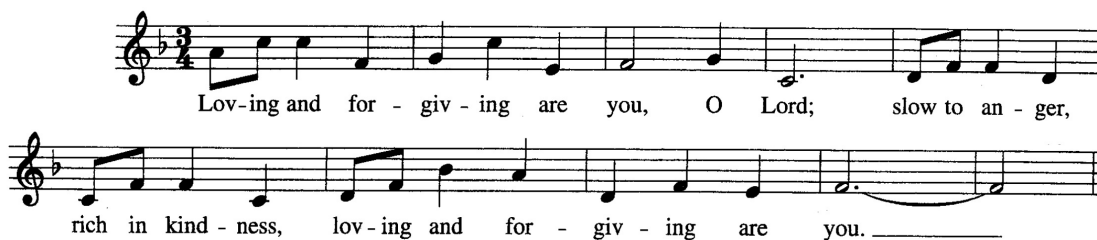
2. The bread that I will give, is my flesh for the life of the world.

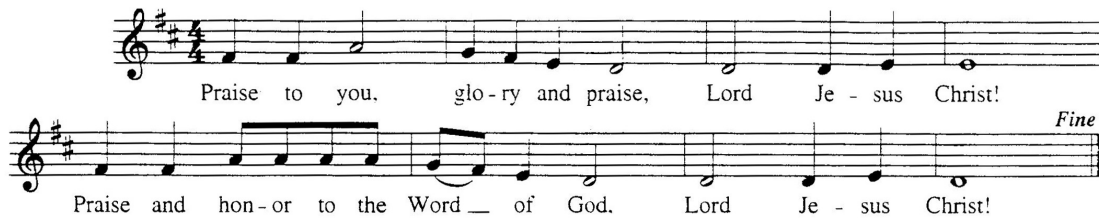
